Mayor Barthlome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilmember Peck gave the invocation.

Clerk Reeves led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on March 16, 2016 were discussed. Motion to accept the minutes of 3/16/16 was made by Councilmember Lloyd. Councilmember Ridenour seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously with Councilmember Peck abstaining from voting due to missing the meeting.

Bills in the amount of \$17,692.69 and payroll in the amount of \$9132.35 were reviewed for payment approval. Councilmember Ridenour moved that the bills and payroll be approved as reviewed. Councilmember Peck seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Curtis Peck reported on the Fire Department. The 6 wheeler has 4 bad batteries that cost \$200.00 each to replace. Superintendent Bredehoft will have Steve Rigby look at it and see if they can be replaced with anything else. If it is not possible Councilmember Lloyd moved to replace the batteries. Councilmember Ridenour seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Barthlome turned the time to Randy Nelson to report on zoning business. He reported that the zoning commission had set a date for a public hearing on a zoning amendment in the Turner

Subdivision for April 27, 2016. He reminded and invited the city council to the public meeting on April 7, at 6:00 p.m. to work on the comprehensive plan.

Superintendent Bredehoft reported that he will approve the following setting permit as soon as the homeowner gets a contractor's license number from their contractor:

Permit # 2016-2, Linda Facer, 420 W Center, Privacy Fence & Pavilion

Superintendent Bredehoft reported that he had visited with an engineer about evaporation ponds for the sewer. The city would need 5 acres for a pond if the pond were 6 feet deep, and 4 acres if the pond were 8 feet deep. The city council will keep this in mind for the future.

Mayor Barthlome reported that she had attended a meeting with the fair board and the board of the Ledge Creek Horse Park. The Ledge Creek Horse Park would like to build an indoor arena at the fairgrounds but there are many details that still need to be worked out.

Mayor Barthlome reported that Agrium had promised to donate \$1,000.00 toward new playground equipment.

Deputy Mabey reported that the sheriff's office has been trying to slow people down on the new bridge west of town because the speed limit is only 25 miles per hour. He also asked the council if they had any concerns that the sheriff's office could help them with. The city council didn't have any concerns but thanked Deputy Mabey for the assistance that the sheriff's office gives the city.

Mayor Barthlome reported that there is a 5 county coalition meeting on April 7, 2016. Clean up week will be held on May 6th – May 16th, 2016.

Discussion was had on purchasing the Heritage Safe Building. Councilmember Ridenour moved that the city not purchase the Heritage Safe Building at this time. Councilmember Lloyd seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
