MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

MAY 18, 2016

Mayor Barthlome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Barthlome excused Councilmember Sotutu.

Councilmember Peck gave the invocation.

Clerk Reeves led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on May 4, 2016 were discussed. Motion to accept the minutes of 5/4/16 was made by Councilmember Peck. Councilmember Lloyd seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Bills in the amount of \$49,842.27 and payroll in the amount of \$9176.35 were reviewed for payment approval. Councilmember Lloyd moved that the bills and payroll be approved as reviewed. Councilmember Ridenour seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Barthlome turned the time to Fire Chief Curtis Peck to report on the Fire Department. He reported that it was the time of year to sign the Mutual Aid agreements with the Bureau of Land Management and the Forest Service. The fire department has been asked to cook at the Concert in the Park on July 15, 2016.

Superintendent Bredehoft reported that he had approved the following setting permits:

Permit# 2016-9 Mike Ridenour, Carport

The city council discussed Customer #2040.4 who had a water line break and cause an unusual amount of water usage. Councilmember Peck moved to write off \$32.25 for the extra water usage. Councilmember Lloyd seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

The next city council meeting scheduled to be held on June 1, 2016 was discussed. It was decided that due to graduation being on that night that the meeting would be moved to May 31, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.

May 18, 2016

Councilmember Peck moved to approve the alcohol license for Patterson's EZ Way, for 2016.
Councilmember Ridenour seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Ridenour moved to cap account #3150.1 if payment is not made by May 23, 2016.
Councilmember Lloyd seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Superintendent Bredehoft reported that there had been a sewer problem at a citizen's home and he was working with ICRMP, the city's insurance, and the homeowner's insurance to take care of the damage done to the home.

Mayor Barthlome thanked the Chamber of Commerce for their help with the clean-up day with the High school and Junior High.

Mayor Barthlome reported that it was reported in the Caribou County Sun that the city had been awarded a grant from the Ifft Foundation Fund for \$4816.00 for a new ADA compliant merry-go-round at the park.

The City Council will hold a budget work meeting on June 8, 2016 at 6:00 p.m.

Superintendent Bredehoft will be getting bids for the streets that the city is going to over-lay this summer.
