

**CITY OF GRACE, IDAHO
MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT GRACE CITY HALL
MAY 31, 2016**

Mayor Barthlome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilmember Sotutu gave the invocation.

Clerk Reeves led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on May 18, 2016 were discussed. Motion to accept the minutes of 5/18/16 was made by Councilmember Lloyd. Councilmember Ridenour seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously with Councilmember Sotutu abstaining from voting.

Bills in the amount of \$4815.26 were reviewed for payment approval. Councilmember Peck moved that the bills be approved as reviewed. Councilmember Sotutu seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Barthlome turned the time to Fire Chief Curtis Peck to report on the Fire Department. He reported that the fire department had responded to a tractor fire in Thatcher. The city department was able to respond 15 minutes sooner than the county department. There will be upcoming training with the EMS. The fire department did tours for the Kindergarten, 2nd and 3rd grades from both Grace and Thatcher.

Superintendent Bredehoft reported that he had approved the following setting permits:

The city council discussed parade candy for the upcoming summer parades. Councilmember Lloyd moved to approve the purchase of candy for the parades. Councilmember Ridenour seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Customer #5090.5 sewer back up was discussed. The customer submitted a bill to the city to pay for Coats & Coats. Clerk Reeves submitted the bill to ICRMP who is working with the homeowner's insurance to get the claims paid.

Superintendent Bredehoft reported that there is a free water conservation workshop on June 7, 2016 in American Falls. He will be taking one employee with him and invited any councilmembers that would like to come as well.

There is a state sale coming up and there are several trailers for sale that would work for mini-track hoe. Superintendent Bredehoft will get more details and report at the next meeting.
