

**CITY OF GRACE, IDAHO
MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT GRACE CITY HALL
SEPTEMBER 7, 2016**

Mayor Barthlome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilmember Peck gave the invocation.

Clerk Reeves led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on August 17, 2016 were discussed. Motion to accept the minutes of 8/17/16 was made by Councilmember Lloyd. Councilmember Ridenour seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Bills in the amount of \$10,425.70 and payroll in the amount of \$10,115.27 were reviewed for payment approval. Councilmember Lloyd moved that the bills be approved as reviewed. Councilmember Sotutu seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Barthlome turned the time to Fire Chief Curtis Peck to report on the Fire Department. A mutual aid agreement with the City of Soda Springs was discussed. Councilmember Peck moved to approve the mutual aid agreement with the City of Soda Springs. Councilmember Ridenour seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Chief Peck also reported that the 700 mhz and 400 mhz radios were updated and reprogrammed so that they can communicate with each other. The fire department will be training on forcible entry and ventilation in October.

Mayor Barthlome turned the time to Zoning Chairperson Randy Nelson to report on zoning business. He reported that the Zoning Commission recommended passing a variance for Chad Hunter to extend the roof of his garage to the fence. The city council discussed the variance and Councilmember Lloyd moved to approve Variance #2016-3 for Chad Hunter. Councilmember Peck seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Zoning Chairperson Randy Nelson also reminded the city council that the meeting with Jim McNall with ICRMP is coming up on September 20, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

Superintendent Bredehoft reported that he had approved the following setting permits:

Mayor Barthlome turned the time to Steve Brady to discuss Grace High School's homecoming. The school is having the Soda Springs Fire Department do a foam party for the tail gate party and they will need some water from a fire hydrant and wondered if the city was willing to donate it. There will also need to be a street blocked off in the Turner Subdivision. Superintendent Bredehoft will bring the barricades to block the street. Councilmember Peck moved to provide the water to the school free of charge as long as the city fire fighters are operating the fire hydrant. Councilmember Lloyd seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

The junk ordinance was discussed. Mayor Barthlome suggested only sending one certified letter to those out of compliance. The city council was in agreement. Clerk Reeves will have Attorney Doug Wood change the ordinance.

Councilmember Ridenour moved to reject the terrorism coverage offered by ICRMP and to approve the Joint Powers Agreement with ICRMP. Councilmember Sotutu seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

The PRIMA training offered by ICRMP was discussed. It is on October 13, 2016 in Idaho Falls. Any of the city council that wishes to attend needs to let Clerk Reeves know as soon as they can.

Superintendent Bredehoft reported that a chopper pump for the lift station will cost \$12,740.00 and he isn't certain that it will fit properly. The salesman is willing to come see but hasn't been able to arrange a time yet. A replacement pump will cost \$621.71 but is 6-8 weeks out. Councilmember Ridenour moved to approve the purchase of a chopper pump at the lift station if it is verified that it will fit. Councilmember Lloyd seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Superintendent Bredehoft also reported that the Department of Environmental Quality is doing an inspection at the Waste Water Treatment Facility on September 14, 2016. He is going to be attending a Water and Waste Water Section meeting in Pocatello on September 8.

Mayor Barthlome reported that a Glow-run fundraiser for the elementary schools will be held on September 8, 2016. They will be shooting a candy cannon. There will also be a high school rodeo this coming weekend. The city summer party will be held on September 8 as well.
