

**CITY OF GRACE, IDAHO  
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
HELD AT GRACE CITY HALL  
DECEMBER 7, 2016**

Mayor Barthlome called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilmember Peck gave the invocation.

Clerk Reeves led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on November 16, 2016 were discussed. Motion to approve the minutes of 11/16/2016 was made by Councilmember Peck. Councilmember Lloyd seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Bills in the amount of \$13,079.01 and payroll in the amounts of \$10,089.28 were reviewed for payment. Councilmember Ridenour moved that the bills and payroll be approved as reviewed. Councilmember Sotutu seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Barthlome thanked the fire department and the Chamber of Commerce for bringing Santa to Grace. There was a good turn out and having it in the fire station was a great success. Councilmember Lloyd informed the council that Monsanto had donated many pairs of nice gloves to the fire department.

Superintendent Bredehoft discussed Setting Permits that have been approved as follows:

The motion to approve the variances discussed at the last meeting was neglected. Councilmember Lloyd moved to approve Variances #2016-6 and #2016-7. Councilmember Ridenour seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Adding long distance to the city hall telephone line was discussed. Councilmember Lloyd moved to approve long distance to the city hall telephone line. Councilmember Peck seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

A bid received from MMA Systems to upgrade the computer system was discussed. The total bid minus tax is \$15,785.93. Councilmember Lloyd moved to approve the bid. Councilmember Ridenour seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

December 7, 2016

Superintendent Bredehoft discussed having the generator at the lift station wired in for back-up power in case of a power outage. Councilmember Ridenour moved to approve to have the generator wired in. Councilmember Sotutu seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Purchasing the merry-go-all for the city park was discussed. Councilmember Sotutu found a similar item for less money. Superintendent Bredehoft will research and compare prices and report back at the next meeting.

Mayor Barthlome and Superintendent Bredehoft informed the city council that they had Henesh Construction come look at making the bathroom at City Hall ADA accessible. It would take up a lot of the board room to make it the size that it has to be, so they would like the city council to consider adding onto City Hall. This won't take place until at least the spring.

Deputy Adam Mabey reported on the activity of the Sheriff's office in the city since November. He also suggested changing the ordinance on RV's to specifically state that no one is allowed to live in an RV in city limits except in the designated RV parks.

Mayor Barthlome thanked the city employees and Dave Yount from Rocky Mountain Power for putting up the Christmas lights.
